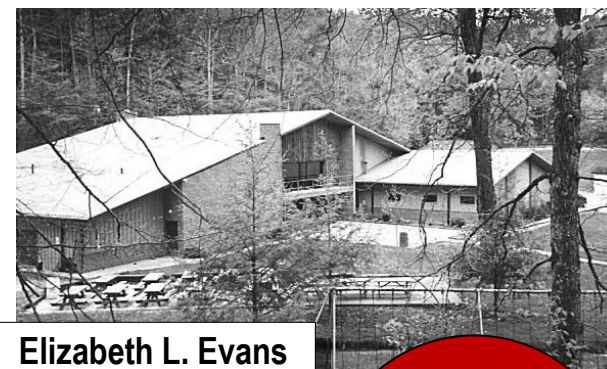

We thought that you may have questions about the 4-H camping program before sending your child to camp and wanted you to be fully informed so that you can encourage your child to take advantage of this opportunity. We've found that 4-H members sometimes don't participate in camp because parents don't realize that camping experiences contribute a great deal to a child's personal growth and development.

The 4-H Camping program offers an excellent opportunity for youth to learn by doing in a fun and interactive environment. At camp, youth will take part in a variety of educational classes and activities, including nature hikes and programs, swimming and water safety, indoor and outdoor recreation, flag and inspirational ceremonies and countless other educational opportunities. Campers will take part in unique experiences and meet many new people during their stay at camp.

The Elizabeth L. Evans Outdoor Education Center, owned and operated by Canter's Cave 4-H Camp, Inc. is one of the finest 4-H camping facilities in Ohio and offers a host of activities and experiences for area youth. The camp is accredited by the American Camping Association and is home to the Ohio 4-H Shooting Sports Program.

The beautiful natural surroundings and modern facilities create an incredible setting for 4-H Camp. Campers stay in cabins or the modern Harrison-Powell lodge and are supervised by trained teen counselors both in their cabins and during their daily activities. **Campers will have the opportunity to choose their cabin/lodge room when they arrive at camp.**
