GAP in Brown Co. Date Changed

Last week, or maybe two weeks ago, I announced a second date for a GAP Training Program for potential tobacco growers for 2018. The first meeting is going to be in West Union on Feb. 22, at Frisch's on St. Rt. 41. The second meeting will be in Georgetown, in Brown County, at the Southern Hills Career and Technical Center on Hamer Road. This second meeting date that needs to be changed. There are other agricultural programming in the area, and issues with the staff from GAP Connections being able to attend on the original date of March 20. The new date will be Wednesday, March 28.

The GAP meeting will be the last one in the area for 2018. Remember the new date is March 28, and the meeting will begin at 7:00 p.m. in the Southern Hills Career and Technical Center. You still need to pre-register by contacting Cindy at the OSU Extension Office in Brown County. Call Cindy Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. Try to avoid the time for lunch, typically from noon until 12:30 p.m. The number to call is 378-6716 and please call before noon on March 27.

Dicamba Training Sites

In the past few weeks, I have included information about the changes that have taken place for using the new technology for Dicamba resistant soybeans. This technology is available from a few companies and they are now requiring training in order to use these products in 2018.

The Ohio Department of Agriculture has made Dicamba a restricted use herbicide. Restricted use pesticides require an applicator license. This is a private applicator license that we offer testing on the second Monday of each month for, and the pesticide re-certifications that are happening in the next few days. With that said, OSU Extension will discuss the use of dicamba in the upcoming trainings, but it will not be the companies require this year.
