Where do I find my log-in information?

- o 4-H Members:
 - Sign in to https://fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/18100 using your 4-H Online log-in information, if you do not know your 4-H Online information, contact Danielle Combs.311@osu.edu.
 - To Access 4-H Online now and in the future please visit: https://4honline.com/#/user/sign-in
 - Login is: your email
 - Password Same password as your previous 4-honline account. Or hit reset password.
 - You should be able to rest your password using your email listed. Save this password as you will use it for future logins with 4-HOnline and Fair Entry.)
- o FFA, Scouts, and FCCLA Members
 - Sign in to https://fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/18100
 - If you are also a 4-H member, use the directions above, and you will be able to choose other organizations once you are signed in.
 - If you are ONLY a member of FFA, Scouts, or FCCLA, sign in by making a Fair Entry account.

% When can I submit entries and when are they due?

 Entries are currently being accepted and the deadline is July 15th. Late entries will be accepted July 15-31st with an additional late fee.

How do I register different projects in different organizations?

 Follow the prompts to choose the department and division, then you should be asked to choose a club/chapter in which your project will be completed through. Be sure your projects are entered with your correct organization.

- What do the UPPERCASE departments mean?
 - All UPPERCASE departments are for Senior Fair competitions.
- What do the departments that start with Jr. mean?
 - o Any department starting with "Jr." means that it is a Junior Fair department.
- **What do departments that start with 4-H mean?**
 - Any department name starting with "4-H" is ONLY for 4-H members, no other organizations are eligible for these projects.
- # How do I find my specific Special Interest or Summer Judging Projects on FairEntry.com?
 - All FCS projects can be found in the 4-H Summer Judging, 4-H Food, 4-H Clothing, and 4-H
 Special Interest departments. Please be aware that even if a project is considered summer judging but is a food project, it will be in the 4-H Food department, etc.
- How do I add an animal to my entry?
 - After you have chosen the department, division, and club/chapter, you will be prompted to select or add an animal to that specific project for livestock project entries.
- **What if I am not 100% sure that I am going to bring this project to the fair?**
 - Even if you are not 100% sure you will complete the project, you should register for it. This is to
 ensure that you can compete with your project if you decide to, otherwise you will not be
 eligible to compete.
- Do I need to sign up for showmanship on FairEntry.com?
 - Yes, if there is any chance you will show in showmanship, please submit an entry for it.
- What if I do not have a tag number for my livestock project?
 - If you are prompted with a question asking for the tag number, and you do not have it, please enter the number 1. If you are not sure which animal you will bring to the fair and have 2, you can put 2 as the tag number for the second animal.
- How do I submit purebred papers for livestock?
 - o If you enter a purebred animal, it will prompt you to upload a copy of their papers. This must be done by July 15th, or the animal will be shown in a crossbred class.
- **Where do I put the 840 (EID) tag number for breeding gilts?**
 - All breeding gilts need to have an 840 (EID) tag, and the tag number should be entered as the premise ID (Farm tag) when completing entries.

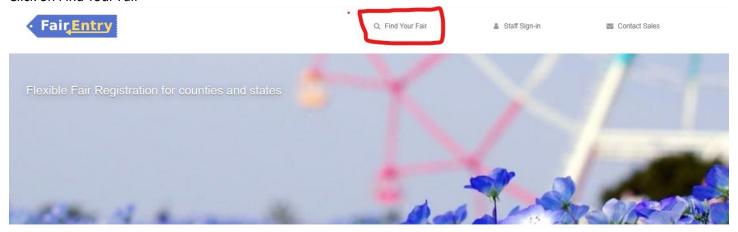

- **Why** is it showing that I have an invoice?
 - All Jr. Fair entries are free, but you will need to click continue to payment to submit your entries. It will not require any form of payment. It will only show a balance when trying to submit your entries if you are registering in Sr. Fair departments.
- **# How do I submit my entries?**
 - Once you have reviewed your entries, bypassed the payment method, and agreed to the terms, you can submit. Kaley will review all entries and either approve or reject them. A confirmation email will be sent, and another email will be sent to you if your entries are rejected.
- **Can I sign up for Nutrition Bowl, Sewing Challenge, Baking Contest, and Demonstration Contest on FairEntry.com?**
 - Yes, you can sign up for these events on FairEntry.com, but we will continue to accept the paper forms, turned into the Highland County Extension Office by August 29th, 2023.

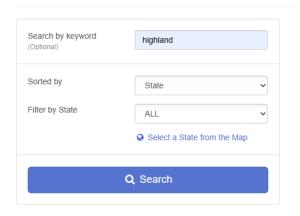

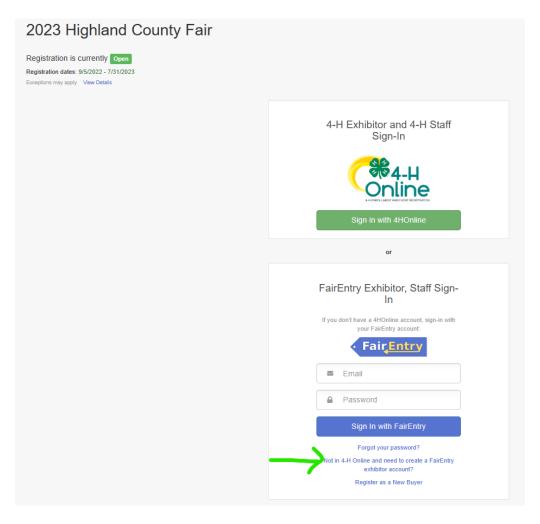

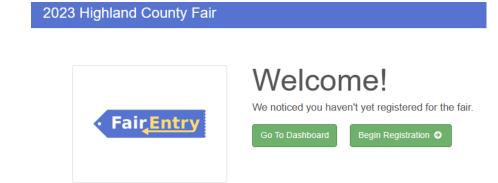


If you are a 4-H member, please use your 4-H Online username and password. (4-H members that also have FFA projects, use your 4-H Online sign-in)

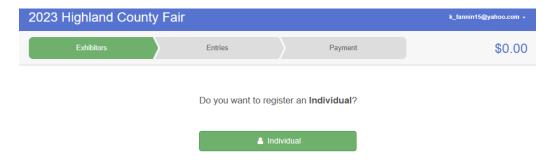
If you are a FFA or FCCLA member, you will need to create a Fair Entry account, see picture below.



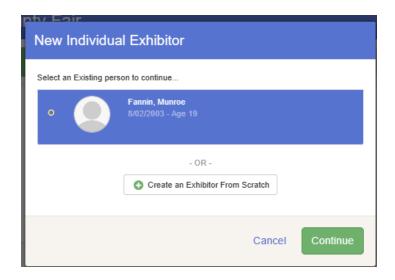
Once you get logged in, it will show you this page. Click begin registration.



You will want to register an individual. Click Individual.



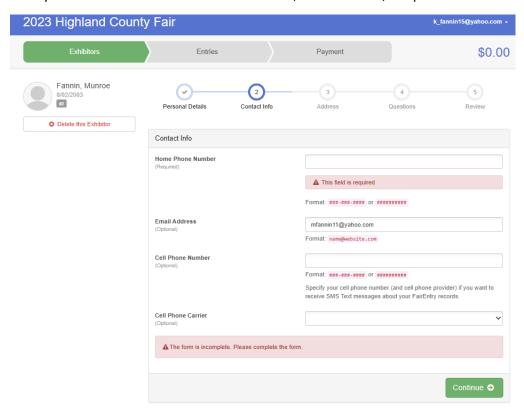
If you already have an account (like the one below) you would select the exhibitor but if you do not have any exhibitors listed, you will need to create an exhibitor from scratch.



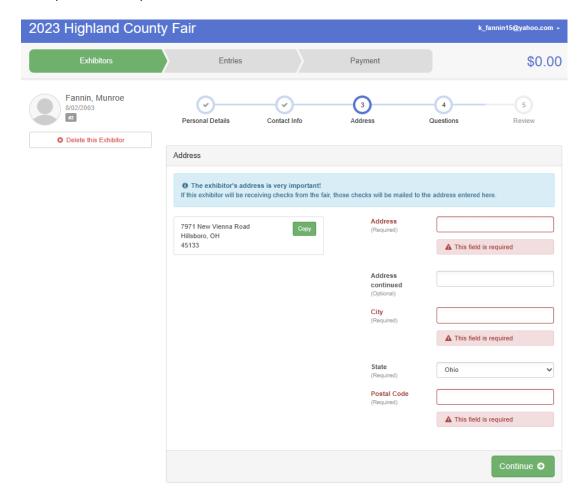
If you are creating an exhibitor from scratch you will need to put in their First and Last name, Date of Birth, and Gender then click continue.



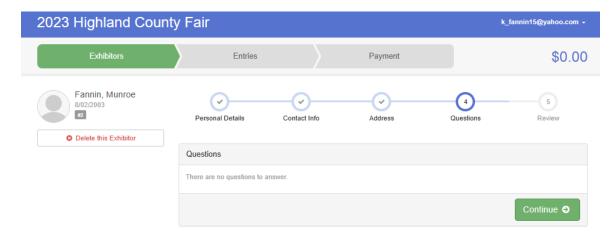
Then you will enter in the Home Phone Number, Email address, cell phone number. Then click continue.



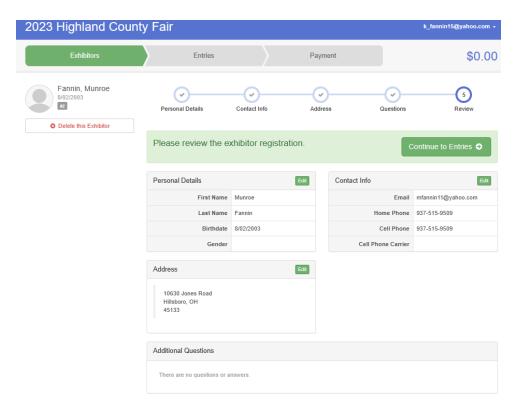
Then you will enter your correct address and then click continue.



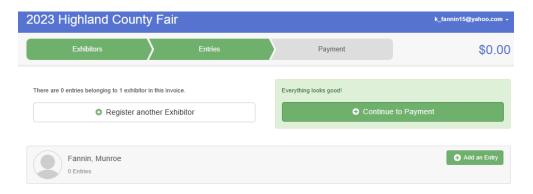
Answer any questions that may be asked. Click continue if there are none.



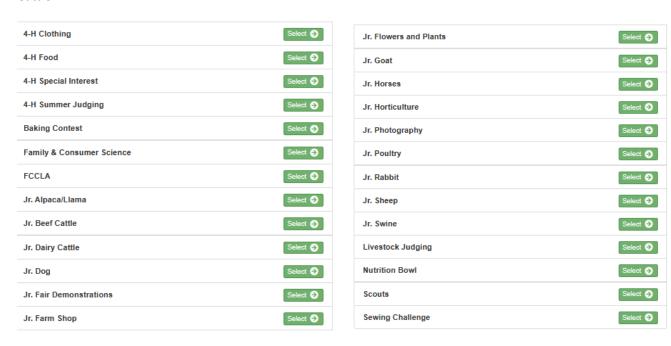
Review all the information that is listed. Click continue to entries.



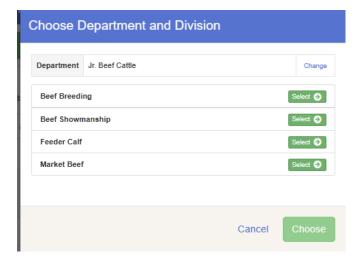
You will click the button that says Add an Entry.



There are Sr and Jr Fair Departments for our Fair. The ones listed below are the Jr Fair Departments. You will need to select which one you will be entering. For this example, we are going to use Jr Beef Cattle. You would select Jr Beef Cattle.



You will need to select which section you are entering for, if you are entering for multiple sections, you will come back for each entry. This exhibitor is going to select Feeder Calf.



Then you will select the green Choose button.



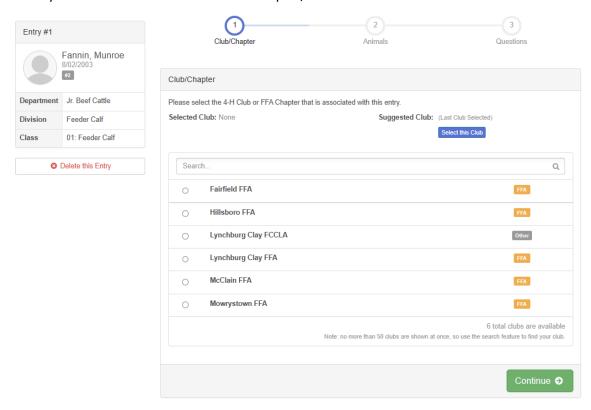
You would then select feeder calf (if not county born and bred) or if it is County Born and Bred Select the 2nd one. Then click select.



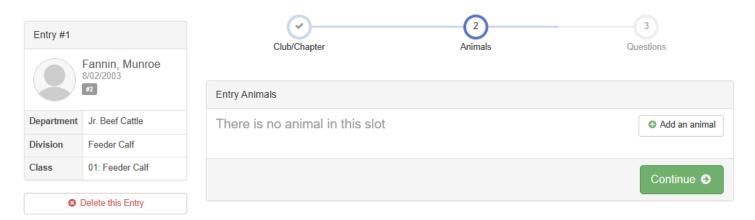
This one selected Feeder Calf. Then select Continue.



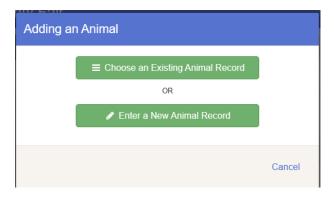
Then you will need to select the correct Chapter/Club. Then Continue.



You will need to add an animal.

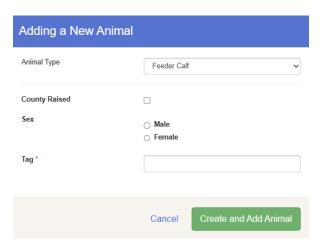


Click Enter a New Animal Record.

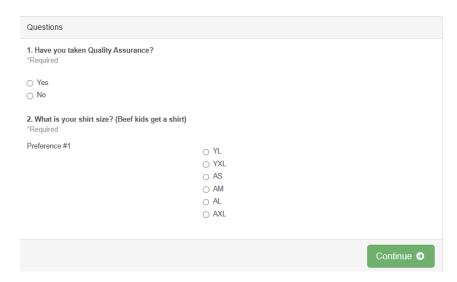


Select the drop down and select Feeder Calf. Select if it's male or female. Then put the tag number in.

**If you do not have your tag number or do not know which animals you are bringing to the fair, you can put Tag 1 in the Tag Number section. (if you are bringing 2 feeders (or whichever animal) you can also put Tag 2 on the second animal if you tagged multiple or family animals).

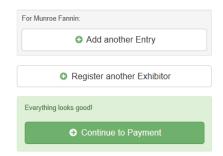


You will need to select if you took Quality Assurance. All exhibitors taking a market project should have taken QA. For the BEEF DEPARTMENT, you will need to select your shirt size for Kim.



If you need to add another animal/entry, you will need to select Add another Entry.

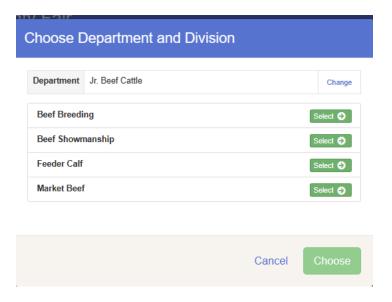
What do you want to do next?



If it's in the same department then you can click change in the division or if you need to go to a different department you can change the department. For this example, we'll stay in the Beef.



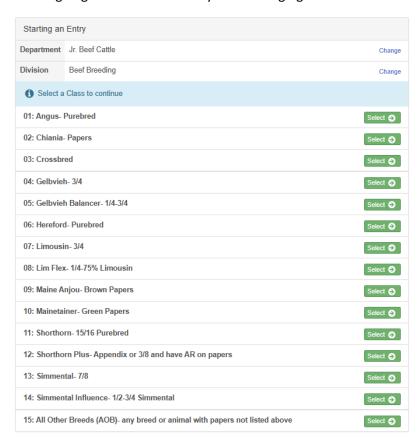
Going to select Beef Breeding and hit select.



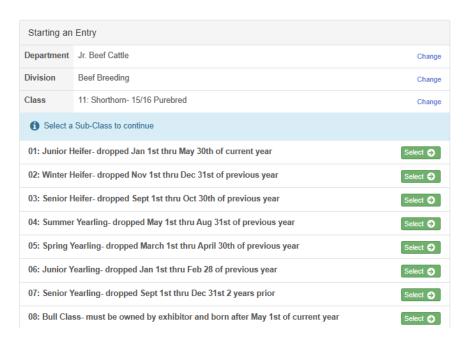
Then click Choose.



You are going to select the breed you are bringing. Then click select.

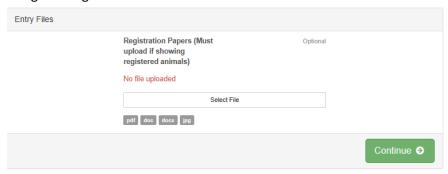


Then you need to select the age of the animal. Then click select.

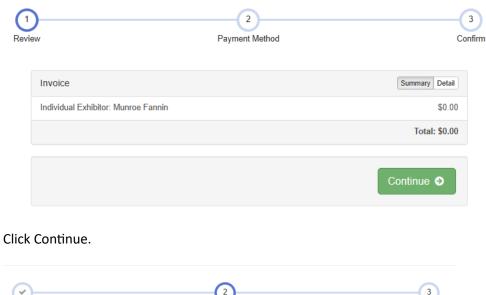


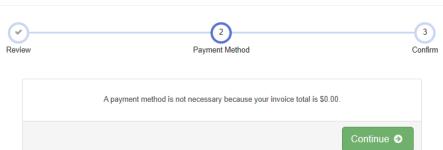
Then you will go through the process of entering a new animal record again.

If it is a purebred animal, you must upload your registration papers. If you don't upload them by the deadline, then they will get changed to the crossbred class. Then click continue.

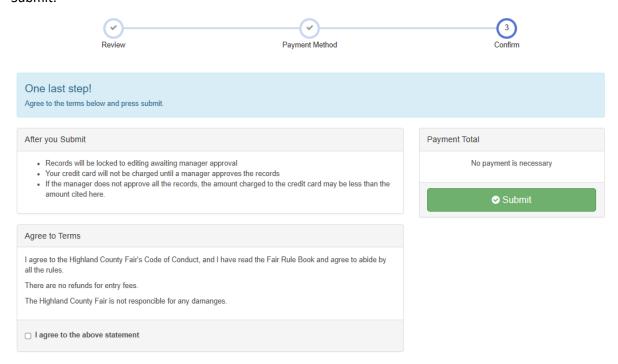


Then once you are done, you will continue to payment. All Jr Fair entries are \$0.00. Click Continue.

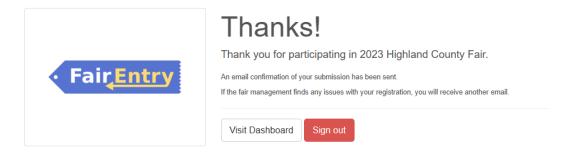




You will need to click the box that you agree to the terms and agree with the statement that is listed. Then you will click Submit.



Once you click submit, the Jr Fair Coordinator will get an email/notification that you have submitted your entries. If you want to look at the status of them to make sure they get approved, click visit dashboard.



This is what the dashboard looks like. You will get an email/notification once the projects are approved or need fixed.
