Ambassador Duties:

- Participate in award presentations during the Jr. Fair at the Highland County Fair. A schedule will be made before the show to ensure ambassadors will have time to prep their project animal(s).
- Assist the llama/alpaca barn superintendents in daily activities and shows; as well as help with preparations for barn set up and clean up as necessary.
- Promote the llama/alpaca industry – Ambassadors are encouraged to attend and offer assistance at any open class show they attend.
- Ambassadors are expected to present themselves in a professional manner at all times.
- Wear sash provided to promote the llama and alpaca ambassador position.

Contest Rules:

- Contestant must be age 9 to 19 years as of January 1st of the current year. Jr. Ambassador will be between the ages of 9-14 years and Sr. Ambassador 15-19 years (4-H age).
- Contestant must be (and remain so if selected) an active 4-H or FFA member in good standing and have a llama or alpaca project registered for the current year at the Highland County Jr. Fair.
- Contestant must participate in an interview focusing on llama/alpaca knowledge, personality, and ability to be a good ambassador to the llama/alpaca show.
- Completed applications must be signed and submitted to the Highland County Extension Office on or before July 1, 2024.
