Contest Rules:

- Contestant must be age 9 to 19 as of January 1st of the current year. Jr. Ambassador will be between the ages of 9-14 and Sr. Ambassador 15-19 (4-H age).
- Contestant must be (and remain so if selected) an active 4-H or FFA member in good standing and have a llama or alpaca project registered for the current year at the Highland County Jr. Fair.
- Contestant must participate in an interview focusing on llama/alpaca knowledge, personality, and ability to be a good ambassador to the llama/alpaca show.
- Completed applications must be signed and submitted to the Highland County Extension Office on or before June 30, 2023.
