

2022 Tagging Procedure

1. All animals MUST be in possession by June 1, 2022 (EXCEPTIONS Market Chickens and Market Rabbits). All market animals must be born on or after January 1, 2022.
2. **Feeder Calves, Hogs (Barrows Only), Boer Goats, and Dairy Goat Exhibitors-** will come to the fairgrounds on June 4th from 8:00am-10:00am to pick up all paperwork and tags. If you want to bring your animals to the fairgrounds to be tagged you will be allowed too. If you choose to NOT bring your animals to Tag-In, make sure you get all the paperwork and tags that day!!
3. **Lamb Exhibitors-** if you would like to participate in the Production Class, the exhibitors will be allowed to bring their animal to the fairgrounds to be weighed and tagged. If you are a Lamb exhibitor and are not planning on participating in the Production Class you do not need to bring your lamb, you may just come and pickup tags and paperwork to be sent back in if you want.
4. All paperwork and pictures must be turned back in by Tuesday, June 15, 2022 (NO EXCEPTIONS). THIS IS ONLY FOR EXHIBITORS THAT DID NOT BRING THEIR ANIMAL TO TAG IN!!
5. Tags will be \$2, so please bring exact change.
6. If you are planning on bringing your animals to the fairgrounds to be tagged, you must register in order to know where you will be tagged at on the fairgrounds, please send an email to highlandcojrfair@yahoo.com, so we can have a headcount on how many will be coming. Please include exhibitors name, species and how many animals will be coming. Please make the subject Tag-In 2022.
7. The following are the 3 options you have in order to return paperwork....
 - A. **There is a mail drop at the Jr Fair Board office that you can leave paperwork.**
 - B. **Mail it to Highland County Junior Fair Board, Attention Kaley Fannin, PO Box 564, Hillsboro, OH 45133.**
 - C. **Email to highlandcojrfair@yahoo.com (make the Subject market species and if you have more than one market species do an email for each species, families can be put together in one email.)**
8. Everyone that does not bring their animals to the fairgrounds will be required to tag their own animals!!
9. Pictures need to be of each side of the animal as well as a picture showing the **tag in the left ear**. Please make sure the pictures are clear and not blurry!
10. Feeder calves will still need to do the Pre-Conditioning papers (yellow). Pre-Conditioning must be done between July 1 and August 1. Paperwork is due August 15th!

When it is closer to Tag-In we will let everyone know where each species will be located on the fairgrounds to pick up paperwork and tags or to be tagged.

*****Chicken order forms still need to be turned in by June 1 with money so they can be ordered from the hatchery!*** Order forms with money can be mailed to the address on the form or dropped off at the Jr Fair Board Office.**
