

2019 Highland County Poultry Ambassador Application

The Highland County Poultry Ambassador Contest is open to all Highland County youth participating in the Poultry program at the 2019 Highland County Fair.

The purpose of this competition is for youth to know and understand the importance of poultry as an agricultural product. The Poultry Ambassador must be able to present a small paper on the Avian Influenzas and its effect on the poultry industry during the poultry shows to inform the public. The Poultry Ambassador will promote the knowledge of raising poultry to produce a food commodity for human consumption. The Poultry Ambassador will promote the versatile use of poultry and eggs in recipes

Eligibility and Prerequisites off Highland County Competition

1. The contest is open to all Highland County youth between the ages of 14 and 19, not married nor has been married, nor (if female) has borne a child.
(The contestant must have passed his or her 14th birthday as of Jan. 1, 2019)
2. All information requested on the form must be provided.
3. The application needs to be **signed by a parent or guardian**.
4. Each applicant must agree to attend an **interview judging**.
5. The winner must agree to attend and preside over **all poultry activities** (such as entry days for poultry, contests, shows, and sale) during the fair from the scheduled start time.
6. The winner must dress neatly as a representative of the poultry exhibitors.
7. The winner must conduct himself/herself properly as a representative of the poultry exhibitors during fair week.
8. The winner must **speak on the microphone** announcing classes or winners and use each opportunity to promote the use of poultry and eggs.
9. The winner must be present to **pass out ribbons and trophies** to the exhibitors.
10. The winner must be available at the request of the poultry barn superintendent.
11. The winner must be available to assist the poultry barn superintendent when all poultry arrives to the barn, exhibition birds and meat birds. The winner must be available to assist the poultry barn superintendent when all contests are going on whether it is the skillathon, poultry shows, egg & poultry judging contest, and the buyer's luncheon during the sale.
12. No contestants can **serve consecutive years** as an ambassador
13. A sash or necktie will be presented to the chosen person who is to serve as ambassador for the current year after the interview and before the fair.
