Tobacco GAP Programs

With the first GAP Session next Tuesday, I am running this again. I know the tobacco contracts are an unknown issue at this point for many producers, but I want to make sure everyone is aware that they need to be GAP certified again this year if they are going to produce tobacco in 2015.

All of the GAP (Good Agricultural Practices) programs require pre-registration. This is primarily so we can provide seating for everyone.
