Prior to being elected to the Ohio General Assembly, he served four years on the Greenfield City Council and eight as Mayor. He also served as a Highland County Commissioner for six years.

Pesticide and Fertilizer Certification

As we get near the first opportunity for pesticide and fertilizer certification I want to remind people that the certification is needed beginning September 30, 2017. So, yes you have time to



complete this training. You can go ahead and get the training and it is my understanding that it will marry up with your pesticide license. So you would need to renew them at the same time in the future. The dates are listed below for those who have a pesticide license. For those who do not have a pesticide license, you will need to attend a different training. It will be a 3 hour session, and I have them scheduled in March. I have one scheduled in each county. On March 12 at Southern State Community College in Hillsboro, March 18 at North Adams High School and March 23 at Southern Hills CTC in Georgetown.

I will have more on this in the coming weeks. However, you do need to pre-register for all of these programs by calling Cindy at the Brown Co. Extension Office at 937-378-6716.
