Frequently Asked Questions**

- ❁ **I don't see my project on the list for judging, when do I get judged?**
  - July Judging will be held on July 11<sup>th</sup> and Pre-Fair Judging will be held on August 12<sup>th</sup>. To find out if your project is a July Judging or Pre-Fair judging, please refer to the [Project Completion Guidelines](#).
- ❁ **Do I need to bring food to judging?**
  - No, to prepare for nutrition project judging please refer to the [FCS Resource Handbook](#).
- ❁ **What are the new changes with clothing projects?**
  - All clothing participants will wear their outfits to judging. After judging, the participants will change and leave their clothing project on a display with the judge. Clothes can be picked up between 5-5:30pm on July 11th or by the end of the week at the OSU Extension Office-Highland County.
- ❁ **What do I need to bring for my project?**
  - To prepare for project judging, use the [Project Completion Guidelines](#) for all requirements.
- ❁ **What goes in a portfolio?**
  - A [Portfolio Handbook](#) is now available to help guide you in assembling your portfolio.
- ❁ **What do I wear?**
  - This is a youth interview, come dressed nicely. Treat this like a job interview. This will help in preparing for the future. Clothes that are ironed, clean, school appropriate, easy to walk in, clean shoes, brushed hair, and/or makeup.
- ❁ **When are the awards?**
  - The Summer Awards are on Tuesday, July 18<sup>th</sup> at 6pm.
  - Pre-Fair Awards are part of the Jr. Fair Awards Tuesday, September 8 in the Multi-Purpose Building during the Fair (fair pass required for attendance).



✿ **When do I need to bring my project and put it on display?**

- All 4-H Special Interest exhibits must be entered and/or confirmed on Saturday, Sept. 2, from 10:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. Please do not wait until the last minute! Projects need to be on display in order to be eligible for premiums.

- Jr. Fair 4-H Style Review and modeling contest will be held during the Highland County Fair.
  - Any 4-H member completing a Family & Consumer Sciences project (clothing & textiles, foods & nutrition, creative arts, home furnishings, health, etc.) and Special Interests shown below are eligible to participate. Modeling awards for 4-H members in clothing projects will be given in three divisions at the fair. Junior Division will consist of Ages 9-10, Intermediate Division will be Ages 11-13, and Senior Division will be Ages 14-18.
